Dede Road Developments:

There is a conceptual plan to put a Recreational Vehicle storage lot on the parcel of land that adjoins the Post Office on Dede Road in Finksburg. The County is also awaiting final plans for the new Mudgett shopping center & Rite Aide store at Dede Road. The designs being reviewed are said to show both Mudgett's and Rite Aide's willingness to work with the county to bring about an attractive new shopping center along the gateway.

Board Meets New Library Chief:

The FPAC Executive Board met with newly hired County Library Director Lynn Wheeler and Assistant Director for Operations Scott Reinhart on January 5th. Lynn Wheeler told the board that Lukmire Partnership has tentatively been awarded the contract to design the new Finksburg Library and library headquarters. Lynn assured the board that there would be numerous community meetings to get input on how the library should be constructed. The new library will be approximately 10,000 square feet and the headquarters will be 14,000 square feet on vacant land on the south side of Old Westminster Pike east of Sandymount Elementary School. Board member Jim Johnson joined Lynn and Scott for a lunch meeting with Greg Lukmire, head of the architectural firm earlier this month to discuss the plans.
