FPACC Board To Unveil Proposed Design Standards:

The FPACC board has been working on proposed new design standards for the county planning department to consider. Much of the proposal is taken from the Route 1 plan in Howard County. The goal is to improve the image and the future landscape of Finksburg and the gateway into and out of Carroll County. We will be sharing several aspects of the proposal to the public on a month by month basis. We encourage you to attend. If you don't like the way Finksburg looks from the bridge to Route 91, please attend. If you are concerned about the current design standards in the county, please attend.

Auto Repair Shop Meeting Scheduled:

The planning and zoning commission has scheduled a March 23rd meeting to consider a request for a house and auto repair shop on 3.5 acres on Old Gamber Road at Route 91. The meeting will be held at the county office building at 1:30 p.m. If approved the building would be 32-thousand square feet with room for 80 parking spaces.
