November FPACC Meeting Set:

FPACC has scheduled its November meeting. The meeting will be held this coming Thursday night, November 16th. On the schedule to appear are State Senator Larry Haines and a Maryland State Trooper 1st Class Dave Keller who will talk about the growing problem with methamphetamine use among residents. Senator Haines was re-elected to another term in the state senate.

Carroll County Considers New Development:

The County Planning and Zoning Commission is scheduled to have a special report on a proposed development called Generals Landing, located west of Murray Road. The property is owned by Shelley Muffly and the developer is Henry Blevins. The meeting is scheduled for November 21st at 2:30 pm in the County Office Building.

Hearing on Proposed Auto Repair Facility:

The County Board of Zoning Appeals has scheduled a hearing November 29th on a proposed automobile repair facility on Old Gamber Road and Route 91 in Finksburg. Owner of the property, Brian DiMaggio is requesting a variance for the building to be 13-thousand square feet instead of the now permitted 10-thousand square feet on property zoned B-NR, neighborhood retail business district. The meeting will be held at 9:30 AM at the County Office Building, room 03/04.

Design Standards Final Form:

The FPACC board has officially completed its work on the proposed design standards for the Gateway. We think these plans are adequate and should be adopted by the county. Liquor Store Opening:
