The November meeting was a community conversation about the history of Finksburg. We will began with a short presentation on The Elms, a stately mansion situated on the old carriage road along the west bank of the Patapsco River just south of the present day Rt. 140 bridge over Liberty Reservoir. The house was built in approximately 1760 and at one time belonged to the son of Francis Scott Key. It was destroyed when the Liberty Reservoir was constructed, but some still remember this fine old Maryland home. Smokers Barbeque Restaurant is being recognized for outstanding design. Located on MD 140 in Finksburg, the attractive new restaurant offers carry out and catering services. Named one of "Baltimore's Best" in 2000, the family-owned and operated business began in 1997 in the Upperco area of Baltimore County. Owner Kurt Kraus wanted to move the operation closer to home in Finksburg and after four years of careful planning and construction they are now open for business. Designed and built by Dave Patton of Patton Homes, the restaurant resembles an attractive residence complete with a stone façade and carefully screened drive-through.
