Community Information Meeting to be Held on Finksburg Corridor Plan

The Finksburg community is invited to an informational meeting on proposed modifications to the Draft Finksburg Corridor Plan, a document that sets goals and guides development along the eastern portion of the Maryland Route 140 corridor in Carroll County. The meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 14, 2013 at 6:00 pm in the social hall of Sandymount United Methodist Church, 2101 Old Westminster Pike, Finksburg, Maryland 21048.

Staff from the County's Department of Land Use, Planning & Development will provide an overview of plan modifications and members of the County Planning Commission will be available for a question and answer session.

The plan is an update to the 1981 Finksburg Area and Environs Comprehensive Plan and focuses on traffic flow in the corridor, protecting the area's environmental resources, and eliminating the growth area designation from the area outside the Route 140 corridor.
