The Finksburg community was invited to an informational meeting on proposed modifications to the Draft Finksburg Corridor Plan, a document that sets goals and guides development along the eastern portion of the Maryland Route 140 corridor in Carroll County. The meeting was Monday, January 14, 2013 at 6:00 pm at the Sandymount United Methodist Church, 2101 Old Westminster Pike, Finksburg.

Staff from the County's Department of Land Use, Planning & Development provided an overview of plan modifications and members of the County Planning Commission were available for a question and answer session.
