Finksburg Development Update: Rezoning request for property at Old Gamber Rd and Gamber Rd (MD 91).



► Finksburg Corridor Plan - APPROVED: (More Information)

August 29, 2013: Carroll commissioners approve Finksburg plan. The Carroll County Board of Commissioners voted 4-1 today to approve the Finksburg Corridor Plan. Commissioner Robin Bartlett Frazier, R-District 1, voted against the plan. The approved plan includes the land use designation change to commercial from conservation (at the corner of Rt140 and Rt91) that many objected to at the public hearing. At the 9/17/2013 planning and zoning commission meeting a discussion was held about implementation of the Finksburg Plan. The first step may be the *rezoning* of the above mentioned parcel.

The Finksburg Corridor Plan has taken over 10 years to complete. There have been numerous changes, starts and stops along the way. The *incredible* journey and timeline of this plan is documented here.
